






DEVELOPED AT THE INTERNATIONAL TRAINING IN SLOVENIA:

- Activities should include the whole family; not children only, but also parents (parenting; empowernment, ...)
- Bulid on families's needs, interests, skills, expectations
- Break the prejudices and stereotypes in the majority population
- Intersectoral collaboration (social services, Romani community, municipality, volunteers)
- Inclusive approach (multicultural groups; inclusion of representatives with the same ethnical and cultural background; first language)





- The most competent professionals
- Motivation for participation
- The frequency and duration of activities and continuity (e.g. when the project finishes etc.)
- **Target groups** (0-3, more 3-6)
