



Using their rights, everyone has to respect the rights of other children and adults.




The child has to be polite and respect the rules of behaviour.


\checkmark On matters relating to child's education:

- If you want to sign up a child in a kindergarten or a school - contact the kindergarten or school administration, on other issues - the group or class teachers
- If there is a disagreement with a teacher contact the kindergarten or school principal
- If you have complaints about a kindergarten or a school contact the municipal Department of Education

The birth registration: in a Registry Office within one month after childbirth

For residence declaration when a child is born or if you change the place of residence: contact the local municipality

If you need social assistance: contact the municipal social workers
